We hope you enjoy the pieces we have put together and remember...

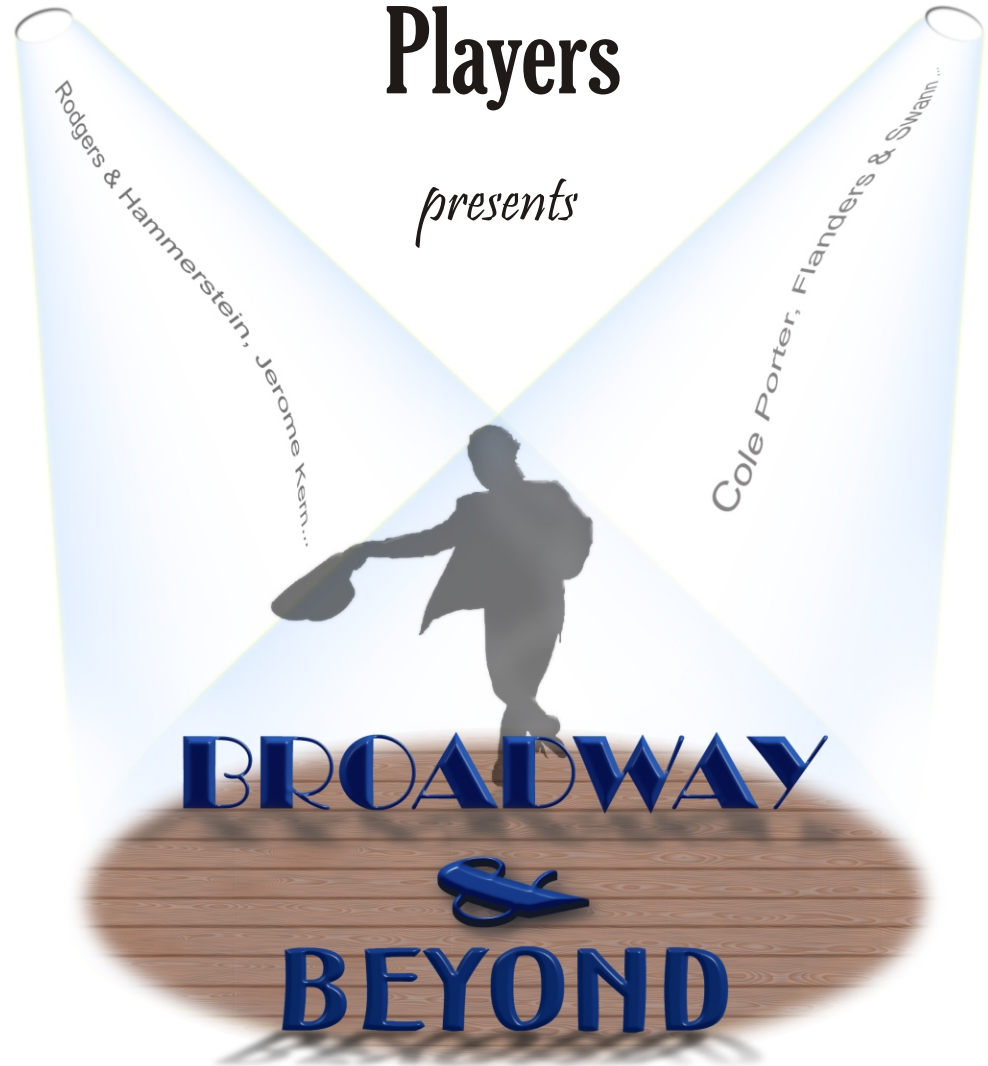

Dorothy is the organist at St. Francis Anglican Church in Mindemoya, and since 1987 has been the director of the Island Singers, a community choir presenting choral repertoire of the last five centuries. When not pursuing musical endeavours, Dorothy works with husband Jim and son Alex, operating the family business, Oshadenah Holsteins.
